Abstract:

In this talk, I will begin by outlining a background for politeness theories, and then briefly overview some of the main classical theories of politeness, such as those of Brown & Levinson, Leech, Lakoff, and Fraser. I will then point to a problem: is politeness essentially a violation of linguistic or communicative rationality—i.e. the Gricean Cooperative Principle? Lakoff (and perhaps Brown and Levinson) seem to suggest that it is, but Leech and Fraser claim that not only is it not a violation of the rules of conversation, it is part of conversational contract—indeed, it is a maxim alongside other conversational maxims. I will overview and discuss their arguments.
