Abstract:

Social emotions, defined as affective states that are not only related to the self, but depend on the social context and arise when we interact with other people. These emotions comprise empathy, shame, guilt, exclusion, pride, envy, trust, etc. in this talk I will focus on some of these emotions namely shame, guilt, pride, and exclusion and I will explain the neural underlying related to the processing of these emotions. Moreover, I will explain how these emotions differently shape our social behavior in respect to others. We will see that shame and guilt could result in two distinct cognitive and social responses in people taking into account the social context. In addition, Social exclusion which is known as a social pain will be explored in terms of its distinct types and how these various types cause different outcomes..
